Open Junior Class: for boys and girls at least 9 years and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: for boys and girls at least 12 years and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: for boys and girls at least 15 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: for boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show and who have won 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar year for this class will be November 1 to October 31 of the following year. Some Helpful Hints --- Potty your dog before testing begins. You may not leave the building once testing begins. Treats are not allowed in the test area or during the test. This includes wearing a treat bag or having treats in your pocket. You need to use a buckle or slip collar (fabric, chain, martingale) or a non-restrictive harness. Pinch collars, no-pull/no-jump harnesses or gentle leaders/head halters are not allowed during the test. You can talk to and praise your dog throughout the test. Relax and have fun! Remember, this is simply just a test --- pass or fail, you go home with the best dog! Handlers may re-test their dog that night at the discretion of the evaluator. Re-test is \$5.00.
